
Celebration Assemblies

SATs and other statutory assessments

Year 6 SATs are week commencing Tuesday 8th May and run until the end of the week, and we are planning to run Year 2 assessments following this. As you know, we keep statutory assessments very low-key for the children. Particularly in Year 2, the actual 'test' only forms part of the overall teacher judgement for the end of Key Stage 1. Pupils in Year 4 will be completing the Multiplication Tables Check this half term, and pupils in Year 1 will also be showing off their awesome phonics skills in the Phonics Screening Check before half term. Your child's class teacher will be more than happy to answer any questions you may have about summer term assessments.




